- Are over the age of 60
- Have a special communication need
- Depend on electricity for home or medical care
- Have a child under 5 years of age
- Have chronic illness
- Or just feel you need a little extra help.

You can also register with us if you feel you need support for a short period of time.

For example: if you are recovering from an operation, if you are pregnant or if you have been recently bereaved and need some extra support.



Finding a friend

Have you ever felt lonely, do your days stretch out endlessly with no one to talk to?

We all need a friend and someone to chat to. More and more people are living alone now and becoming isolated and lonely.

We have a number of partners who offer a befriending service. They will link you with local friends who can come to visit you or meet with you for a chat and a cup of tea or talk to you on the phone.
